Founded in 1869, headquartered in the park of Valentino, the rowing club has been the protagonist of Italian rowing for more than 150 years. Originally called "Mek-Mek", the rowing club was born from the merger with Flik-Flok in 1869.

The Po River, known as "Il Po" in Italian, is the longest river in Italy, spanning approximately 652 kilometers (405 miles). It has a significant role in the geography, economy, and culture of northern Italy.

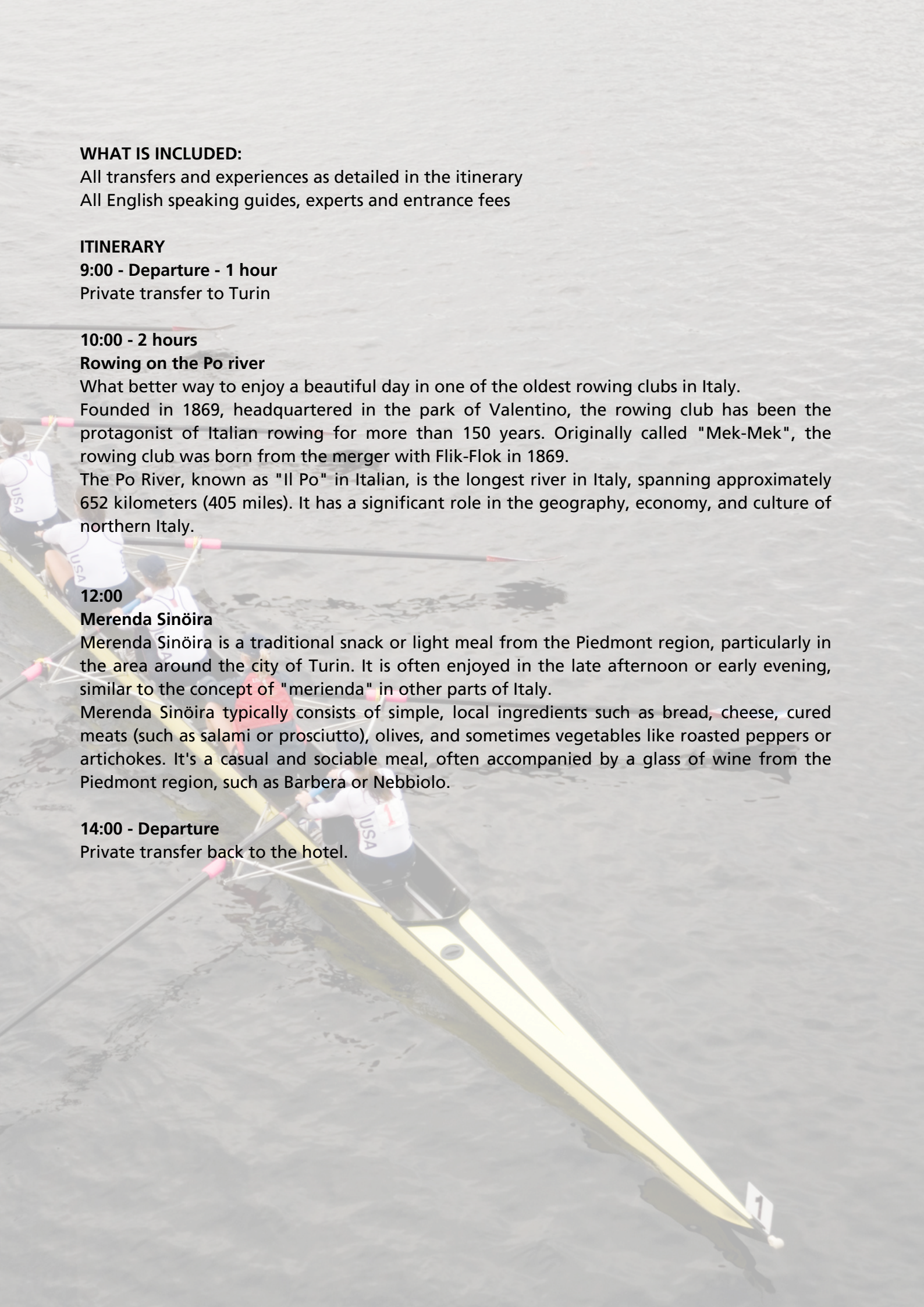
Merenda Sinöira

Merenda Sinöira is a traditional snack or light meal from the Piedmont region, particularly in the area around the city of Turin. It is often enjoyed in the late afternoon or early evening, similar to the concept of "merienda" in other parts of Italy.

Merenda Sinöira typically consists of simple, local ingredients such as bread, cheese, cured meats (such as salami or prosciutto), olives, and sometimes vegetables like roasted peppers or artichokes. It's a casual and sociable meal, often accompanied by a glass of wine from the Piedmont region, such as Barbera or Nebbiolo.
